# WHAT WOULD IT LOOK LIKE FOR US TO BE KNOWN AS A "PRAYING" CONGREGATION?

Of course, all churches pray, and most of us have our own individual prayer practices as well. But the Pew Research Foundation says that only 55% of Americans pray daily. So perhaps our prayer life could use some attention as we grow together in faith.

As we kick off the program year this month, we're beginning the year with a sermon series on the Lord's Prayer. It's an invitation to learn by heart and to pray with intention the prayer Jesus taught. But more broadly, it's a chance for us to talk about and to practice praying together. As you participate in programs, gather in small groups, go to Sunday School, and more, I wonder how our life together would be strengthened by praying for one another. Maybe you pay attention to the prayer list in the eNews. Maybe you commit to saying grace at dinner each night. Maybe you join the centering prayer group on Thursdays or find a moment to turn off your music or podcast and simply breathe during your morning walk. However you choose to engage, my invitation to you as we begin a new school year together is to commit to pray.

Your prayer takes on deeper meaning when you build relationships with those you are praying with and for, so alongside that spiritual practice, you're invited to find a way to connect with other this fall. Take particular note of a few new offerings: a young adult affinity group and our new mid-week worship offering "Middle Ground" that you can read more about in the MAG.
















# MORNINGSIDE SINGS BROADWAY'S PULITZER PRIZE WINNING MUSICALS 9TH ANNUAL BENEFIT PRODUCTION

Rehearsals, design collaboration and production planning are igniting teamwork among more than thirty-five singers, arrangers, instrumentalists, designers, and volunteers from Morningside's congregation. No Day but Today: Morningside Sings Broadway's Pulitzer Prize Winning Musicals will be presented Saturday, August 26 at 7:00 PM and Sunday August 27, at 3:00 PM. Donations collected at the performances will benefit our music programs and mission partners.

When planning this year's production, Jeff Peters and Michael Siedschlag turned to nine musicals that have won the Pulitzer Prize for Drama. The show covers 1932-2016 including Of Thee I Sing, South Pacific, Fiorello!, How to Succeed in Business Without Really Trying, A Chorus Line, Sunday in the Park with George, Rent, Next to Normal, and Hamilton. The production will feature classic and contemporary Broadway standards including "Some Enchanted Evening," "What I Did for Love," "Seasons of Love," and "Alexander Hamilton."

The creative team chose the benefit production's title tune, "No Day but Today" from *Rent*, with care, noting that it captures the essence of this annual evangelism event: to create a performance of inspiring harmony that enables guests, families, and friends to experience the warmth of our beautiful church home. 


